

## NEBOSH International Diploma

From 2012 Impac will be delivering the NEBOSH International Diploma in Occupational Safety and Health using a range of blended learning methods.

Blended learning provides a cost-effective mixture of classroom training and distance learning along with individual tutor support, reducing the time spent in the classroom and allowing greater flexibility. We will work with you to develop a personalised study plan based on your intended target dates to complete each unit. You have a maximum of 5 years to successfully complete Units A, B, C and D in order to be awarded the Diploma. We recommend that you aim to complete it within 1-2 years for maximum success.

Each unit will include classroom training providing you with valuable face to face contact with our highly experienced tutors as we go through the principles of the unit and work with you to understand the direction of the additional study required and the resources available. We will provide you with comprehensive course materials and a study workbook for each element. Revision workshops will be held prior to exams. Outside the classroom you will have unlimited support by phone, email or online with a dedicated webpage hosting additional study information, forums and online assistance.

Full Course: 10 Days classroom learning plus 395 hours private study plus 4 days of revision workshops made up as follows:

- Core skills: 19 hours private study
- Unit A: 5 Days plus 130 hours private study
- Unit B: 2.5 Days plus 95 hours private study
- Unit C: 2.5 Days plus 95 hours private study
- Unit D: 56 hours private study

Please note Units do not have to be completed in alphabetical order. You can start at any stage.

★Also please note that NEBOSH have made changes to the syllabus which will affect all exams taken after January 2013. Therefore if you start Unit B or C in August 2012 but do not intent to take the exams until July 2013 you will need to undertake additional private study to cover the revised elements.

On completion of Units A, B & C, Impac will contact you regarding submission of the Unit D assignment. This assignment should be undertaken while studying the other units however cannot be submitted until completion of all the other Units. Submission dates for Unit D are March and September.

The Unit fee includes: Course manual and workbook

- Attendance at 1 classroom training block
- Attendance at 1 revision workshop
- Unlimited support
- Access to diploma website with online support and extensive H&S library to assist with study.

## ***What we will offer:***

### ***Tutor-led workshops***

We will run a 1 week workshop twice a year, facilitated by two or more experienced NEBOSH approved tutors. The workshops will be scheduled to run at the beginning of each unit. 1 or 2 day Revision workshops will be run 4 weeks prior to exams for each unit. Enrolment will allow candidates to attend 1 workshop and 1 revision workshop per unit at any time during their five year enrolment period; additional workshops will be charged.

The workshops will serve the following functions:

- Face to face contact and networking opportunity for candidates and tutors
- Summary of the key parts of Units A, B and C
- Revision and clarification of any area of the syllabus as requested by candidates prior to attending the workshop
- Feedback on Unit D assignments submitted for checking before the workshop and completion of assignment logs
- Examination preparation

### ***A dedicated website***

Candidates will be able to log into a secure website and download all course materials, administration documents and related documents. The website will also contain tutor profiles detailing their areas of expertise and experience.

### ***Comprehensive training manuals and workbooks***

We provide a comprehensive set of training manuals and workbooks covering the entire International Diploma Syllabus. Training manuals cover each element individually and contain study questions based on the syllabus requirements, as well as a list of references and sources of further information. The workbooks contain practical exercises and practice examination questions to enable candidates to self-assess their progress and understanding of the course content.

### ***Tutor support***

We will provide access via email and telephone to Impac tutors for study support throughout the year. Tutors will be equipped to assist candidates as they study the course content and complete the workbook exercises. Tutors will also help candidates to plan their study and assess their progress towards exam readiness.

## ***Study forum***

Our website will provide a study forum accessible via login and password. The forum will allow candidates to discuss syllabus issues amongst themselves and pose questions to tutors. The forum will be moderated by appropriately qualified tutors and all technical advice peer-reviewed.

## ***Health and safety reference library***

Candidates will have access to Impac's comprehensive library of health and safety resources, including publications, photographic libraries and video collections. These resources are grouped to match the subjects covered in each element of the International Diploma.

## ***Individual learning plans***

Using our web-based learning management system we will assist candidates to set out their study plan on a week by week basis, leading up to the exam dates.

The system will:

- Send automatic email alerts to candidates prompting them to complete a workbook for a particular element
- Allow candidates to upload a completed workbook for tutor comment
- Send an automatic alert to tutors prompting them to comment on the uploaded workbooks
- Allow tutors to upload individualised comments and indicate whether the workbook has been successfully completed or not
- Candidates will be able to access their profiles to check on progress

The system will at a glance show an individual candidate's progress against their learning plan.
